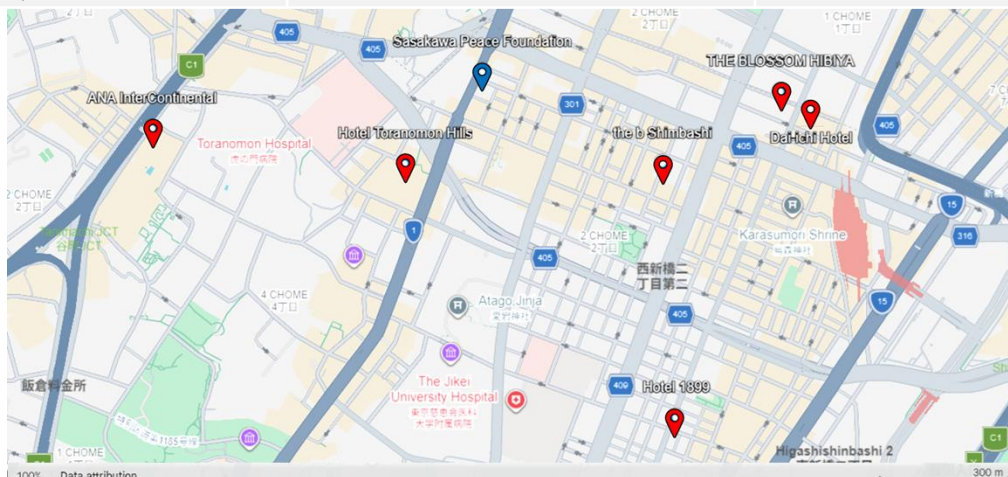

AIRPORT TRANSPORTATION

■ By Train

Choose your train company depending on your airport and the destination.

Haneda International Airport

Tokyo Monorail (Local only) Recommend

In general, Tokyo Monorail is convenient to access central Tokyo. **30 min. 686yen**



Keikyu Railway (Local only)

Keikyu has a good access to take a Shinkansen to go to Osaka or Kyoto. **45min. 505yen**

Narita Airport

Narita Express (Express)
53 minutes to reach Tokyo Station 3,020 yen

■ By Airport Limousine Bus (NRT, HND)

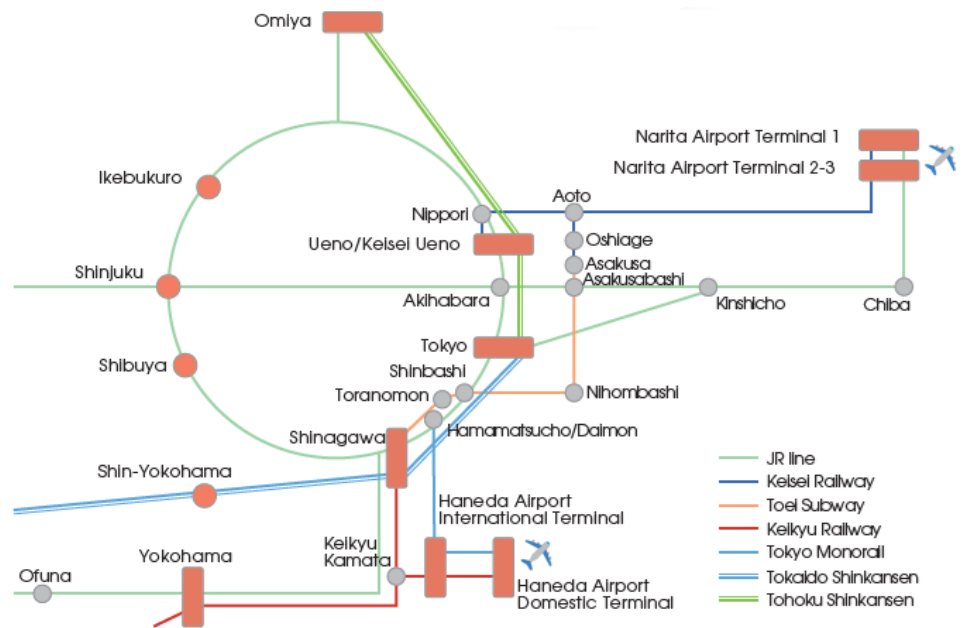
If the limousine bus stops at your hotel, the limousine bus would be an alternative option.

■ By Taxi

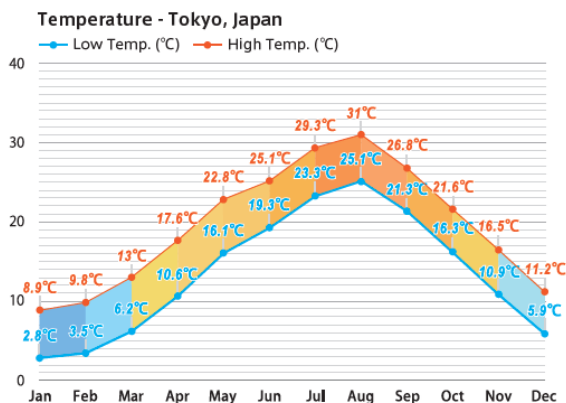
- From Haneda International Airport(HND):

GETTING AROUND TOKYO

Getting around Tokyo by train is very convenient. It is helpful to get a Welcome Suica card at the airport, as in many cases you cannot use a credit card to enter the gates.

INTERNET CONNECTION

Free Wi-Fi is available at many train stations in Tokyo, including Tokyo Metro and JR stations. In the SPF building, SPF provides free wi-fi internet access for our guests. Login details will be provided on-site. For seamless internet access during your stay in Japan, we recommend using a prepaid SIM card or an eSIM.

VOLTAGE

Japan uses 100V electricity with 50/60Hz frequency. This is lower than in many countries, so adapters may be needed.
